- Miniature Golf; Design and Construction, design, construction and permanent installation of unique holes for a public, miniature golf course in Georgetown, KY
- Visions & Visionaries, experiential course using travel and visiting speakers to explore the creativity & drive of visionaries. Students create their own visionary work
- Visions of Death, experiential course using travel, vision quests, ghost-hunting and speakers to explore indelible images of the dead. Students create work from their visions of death
- Community Engagement Through the Arts, a interdisciplinary course designed to be team-taught and to find meaningful ways to engage the immediate community. First offered in Spring 2008 as team taught with a colleague from English.
- User Created Content, (will be taught for the first time in 2008) A critical assessment of web-based technologies that enable users to create their own content--with explorations of YouTube, Flickr, Wikipedia, Digg, etc. Students will become active participants by creating media artworks specifically for these web sites
